Examples of your work:

- 1.) CD-R Portfolio of 10 examples of personal work. Please DO NOT use a smart phone to take these images. Image quality is very important. Images of your work should be clear, actuate and truthful to the finished artwork. <u>Scholarship winners may be asked to provide the original artwork submitted for this scholarship.</u>) All files and disk must be a MAC compatible disk.
- 3.) Portfolio disk must be labeled with student's full name and address.

Required Guidelines for Image Files:

- 1) All examples of work must be in jpg format. PLEASE, do not put files into folders.
- 2) Your image files must be titled starting with two digit numbers (e.g. 01title.jpg, 02title.jpg...).
- 3) Your image list must follow the same name and order as your files. (See the Image List Form attached).

Tips:

- 1.) Remove art work from frames to avoid glare.
- 2.) Use a steady tripod or steady surface to photograph your work. This will allow you to photographic the artwork clearly.
- 3.) DO NOT USE your smart phone to photograph you work!
- 4.) Frame the artwork within the view finder so the artwork takes up as much of the viewfinder as possible. Make sure the piece is squared perfectly in the view finder.
- 5.) Double check your exposure with the preview screen to make sure the image is neither under nor overexposed. Make sure all the detail is visible in both the highlights and shadows.
- 6.) Upload photographs to a computer and use photo editing software to crop out all space surrounding the artwork. DO NOT edit the artwork <u>Scholarship winners may be asked to provide the</u> original artwork submitted for this scholarship.
